#### CHAPTER FINANCIAL REPORT

The chapter's financial status as of end of February 2024 is:

Frost Bank Checking Account	17,835.31
Frost Bank Money Market Account	68,183.36
Net Worth (Assets less Liabilities)	88,693.67
William E. Hayes Scholarship Fund	8,382.35

In early March, the Finance Committee (Elizabeth Kutz/Treasurer, Ed Ackermann/Deputy Treasurer, and Dennis Opferman met to invest a good portion of the Frost Bank Money Market Account in U.S. Treasury Bills to earn a greater return than the Money Market account earns. Note that the Money Market account has yield a considerably higher interest than when the funds were held in a Comerica Bank savings account.

All tasks for converting Comerica Bank checking, savings and credit card account to Frost Bank accounts has been completed. Purpose for the conversion was to seek better interest on our savings and better credit card account features.
