Instrument: 3-manual Allen G340 Digital Organ with 200 variable "Genisys" stops and blue-tooth air turn Parking instructions: Park in the parking lot adjacent to the building – come up the sidewalk by the playground and enter at the office door (you will see signage for the office) and take U turn into the sanctuary.

Instrument: 3-manual Martin Digital Organ

Two symphonic pipe organs (digital samples) loaded

Primary organ: 1895 Willis (67 stops on solo, swell, great, choir, pedal divisions)

Hereford Cathedral organ; recorded with actual cathedral reverberation

Chimes (digital sample of Deagan chimes) – installed with primary organ

Alternate organ: 1999 Rieger (64 stops on solo, swell, great, choir, pedal divisions)

Parking instructions: Park on the EAST side of the church, nearest the chapel. Enter the CHAPEL door.

Note: The WEST doors will be locked, so please enter on the east side as instructed.

6:00 pm | Reception prior to recital | First Presbyterian Church |1000 Penn Street | FW 76102

Parking instructions: Park across the street in the parking lot. As you look at the church, enter the left entrance for the reception (Great Hall entrance). As you enter, you will see the West Concourse ahead of you, which is where the reception will be located. **NOTE: The reception is PRIOR to the recital. This is not an error.**

7:00 pm | Duo Organ Recital | First Presbyterian Church | Sanctuary | 1000 Penn Street | FW 76102

Simon Menges studied organ at the Robert Schumann University in Düsseldorf, Southern Methodist University in Dallas and at the Berlin University of the Arts. In 2010 he completed his concert exam in organ with distinction in Berlin. In 2017 he completed a Master's Degree in Choir and Orchestra conducting at the Zurich University of the Arts. He has been a church musician at the Evangelical Church in Arbon since 2010, where he founded the "International Organ Festival Arbon."

Eun-Hye Lee, spouse of Simon Menges, studied church music at Seoul Theological University and organ in Berlin at the University of the Arts, graduating with "summa cum laude" honors. Her post-graduate work was in early music at the Schola Cantorum Basiliensis in Switzerland. She was awarded the 2nd prize at the international "Franceso D'Onofrio" organ competition in 2004 in Italy and has been organist at St. Johannes Weinfelden in Switzerland since 2011.

WE NEED MORE SUBSTITUTES!

If any of you want to be listed as a substitute and are not already on the list, please contact me so that you can be added to the list posted on our website. You may be available every day or only during the week for funerals and weddings, but not on Sundays. To qualify, you must be a chapter member in good standing and have a degree in organ performance or hold an AGO certification (SPC, CAGO, CHM, AAGO, FAGO) or pass an audition.

IF YOU WANT TO ADD TO THE ABOVE SLATE, write a petition to nominate yourself or another member (must be a member with voting privileges as defined above) added to the slate stating that you have verified that your proposed candidate is willing to serve if elected. Have the petition signed by 5 other chapter members with voting privileges. **Deliver your signed petition to Chapter Secretary Alissa Brewer by midnight April 1, 2020. Petitions delivered after that time will not be accepted.** You may deliver your petition by postmarked US mail, as a scanned electronic file by email, or deliver in person.

NEW EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE INTERIM APPOINTMENTS

At their March 1, 2020, meeting, the Executive Committee voted to approve the following Executive Committee staffing actions:

1. Accepted the resignation of elected Treasurer, **Joe Breedlove**, who was short 5 months of completing his second two year term. A big thank you to Joe for his service during the administration of the previous dean and for the current administration.

2. Appointed **Elizabeth Kutz, CAGO**, as interim Treasurer to fill out Joe's elected term that ends June 30, 2020. Note that Elizabeth is on the spring election ballot as a Treasurer nominee. (Ed Ackermann, CAGO, remains in the position of Deputy Treasurer, an appointed position in the Finance Committee.)

3. Accepted the resignation of Director, **Ed Ackermann, CAGO**, who was appointed to serve out the elected term of Josh Lang when Josh moved to east Texas. Ed has several other chapter jobs and wanted a young organist to gain experience on the Executive Committee.

4. Appointed **Andy Rose** to fill in after Ed Ackermann to complete Josh Lang's elected term as a Director (term ends June 30, 2022). Andy also serves as the Chapter Webmaster.
